Dr. Rajesh Khanna, right, an internationally recognized LASIK and refractive vision care specialist, has written a new book. *Prelex*, his first book, explains the Prelex procedure in its entirety. He also explains the basics of the human eye, vision and how vision changes over time. LASIK is a term that most are familiar with and needs little explanation. Presbyopia is the inability of the old, thick, resistant lens to change shape and focus power.
